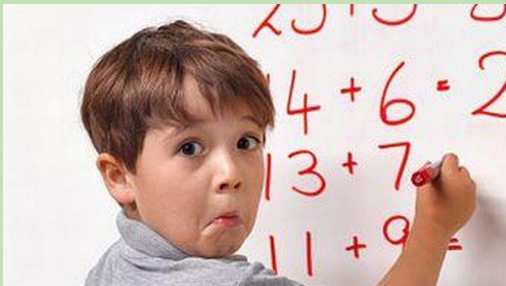

Deciding how a child will receive services is one of the most important decisions in which parents will participate. Special education services are to be provided in the child's least restrictive environment (LRE). This means that a child must receive services in the regular classroom whenever possible. The team will consider moving a child to a different setting only if that child cannot succeed in the regular classroom with services and supports.
